PRAYING FOR ALL SOULS IN NOVEMBER

Traditionally, the month of November is dedicated to praying for the souls of those who have died, in particular the souls in Purgatory. As we did last year, we will once again be having an All Souls Day candlelight procession to the cemetery. There will be Mass at 6:30PM on Wednesday November 1st at St. Michael's followed by a candlelight procession to St. John's Cemetery. Additionally, you should have received an envelope with your regular collection envelopes for All Souls Day. These are available to write the names of your loved ones who have died. All envelopes will be placed on the altar for the month of November. May the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.

ANNUAL MASS ATTENDANCE COUNT

For the purposes of Pastoral Planning (the restructuring of the diocese in terms of the number of parishes) the diocese does an annual Mass count during the month of November. I think our attendance numbers are healthy, but it is important to show evidence of the vibrancy of our parish, especially in terms of Mass attendance. I ask that ALL parishioners be aware of this count and how important it is for the bishop as he makes decisions about the future of the diocese and our parishes.

USE OF BATHROOMS

This past weekend the bathrooms at St. Michael's had to be closed for some maintenance issues. This provides me with the unfortunate opportunity of addressing two issues in regards to the bathrooms in Church. First, please do not send children to the bathroom by themselves, they should always be accompanied by an adult. Second, visits to the bathroom should be for emergencies. The endless string of people going to the bathroom has become a huge distraction, especially at St. Michaels where the bathroom is in the front of the Church. Obviously, emergencies happen, however, visits to the bathroom during Holy Mass should be rare. If needed, please use the bathroom before Mass. In particular I would ask that everyone refrain from making trips to the bathroom during the liturgy of the Eucharist (after the bells have been rung and everyone is kneeling), this is the holiest part of the Mass and everyone's effort at reverence is appreciated.

CATECHESIS ON HOLY MASS

There is an area of proper behavior in church which was unheard of 20 years ago: how to use (and not use) cell phones and other digital devices. The exceptions are emergencies (really big ones, not everyday ones) and if you must use one, please walk out of church to do so. If you are using your smart phone for readings or prayers, this is not inappropriate, but please try to be discreet. Not everyone will understand what you are doing; you may get a curious look from someone who thinks you're texting!

CATEQUESE SOBRE SANTA MISSA

Há uma área de comportamento adequado na igreja que era inédita há 20 anos: como usar (e não usar) telefones celulares e outros dispositivos digitais. Os telefones celulares devem ser deixados do lado de fora ou pelo menos desligados na igreja. Eles nunca devem ser usados na missa para ligações ou mensagens de texto. As exceções são as emergências (as realmente grandes, não as diárias) e se você precisar usar uma, saia da igreja para fazê-lo. Se você estiver usando seu smartphone para leituras ou orações, isso não é inapropriado, mas tente ser discreto. Nem todo mundo entenderá o que você está fazendo; você pode receber um olhar curioso de alguém que pensa que você está enviando mensagens de texto!

USO DE LAVATORIO

No fim de semana passado, os banheiros tiveram que ser fechados por alguns problemas de manutenção. Isto me dá a infeliz oportunidade de abordar duas questões relativas aos banheiros da Igreja. Primeiramente, por favor, não mande as crianças sozinhas ao banheiro, elas devem estar sempre acompanhadas por um adulto. Em segundo lugar, as visitas ao banheiro devem ser para emergências. A fila interminável de pessoas indo ao banheiro tornou-se uma grande distração, especialmente em St. Michaels, onde o banheiro fica na frente da Igreja. Obviamente, emergências acontecem, porém, as idas ao banheiro durante a Santa Missa devem ser raras. Se necessário, use o banheiro antes da Missa. Em particular, peço que todos evitem ir ao banheiro durante a liturgia da Eucaristia (depois que os sinos tocam e todos estão ajoelhados), esta é a parte mais sagrada da Missa e o esforço de reverência de todos são apreciados.

ORANDO POR TODAS AS ALMAS

Tradicionalmente, o mês de Novembro é dedicado à oração pelas almas dos falecidos, em particular pelas almas do Purgatório. Como fizemos no ano passado, teremos mais uma vez uma procissão à luz de velas do Dia de Todas Almas até o cemitério.
