LIVESTOCK AUCTION



LET YOUR VOICE BE HEARD

The Massachusetts State Legislature will consider passing into law two deeply troubling bills this legislative session. They are identical in text but differ slightly in their titles. The first, (House Bill 3320) is "An Act removing obstacles and expanding access to women's reproductive health". The second, (Senate Bill 1209) is "An Act to remove obstacles and expand abortion access". Current law would be dramatically changed by: 1) Expanding abortion access, including late term abortions, during the nine months of pregnancy for virtually any reason. 2) Eliminating any requirements that abortions be performed in a hospital. 3) Eliminating the requirement that provides medical care to a child who survives an abortion attempt. 4) Eliminating the requirement that a minor under the age of 18 have the consent of a parent, guardian, or the courts. 5) Expanding state funding for women who cannot afford the procedure. Contact your legislators, let them know you are a Massachusetts voter, and say NO on Abortion Expansion! 
MY PARISH APP
