ORGAN REPAIRS FOR BOTH PARISHES

Music is such an important part of our Sunday Worship as it helps us to sing to the Glory of God. To ensure that the organs in both churches are working properly, there is some necessary maintenance that must be done to each organ. The organ restoration and maintenance at St. Joseph's has been on-going and we are currently in the third phase of the project. We have currently raised \$4,167 of the \$17,500 needed to complete this next phase. At St. Michael's, we need to replace the two keyboards on the organ and also the MIDI computer. The repairs to the St. Michael's organ are estimated at \$4,500. 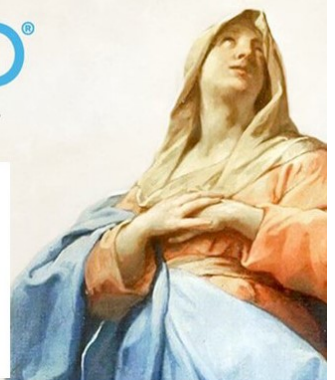
LIGHTHOUSE MEDIA
