**BOILER REPAIRS NEEDED AT SCHOOL**

Last week, one of the two boilers in the school building developed a major crack and after having it inspected by two different companies, it was determined that the older boiler needs to be replaced before the winter. The cost of the new boiler is \$35,000 - A cost that will be split between the parish and the school, as the building is used by both. Obviously, this is not something that was expected, and this is a major expense to our parish. I kindly and humbly ask for your generosity in helping with the installation of a new boiler. Last year, at St. Michael's our average weekend attendance was **906** and at St. Joseph's, our number was **609**.

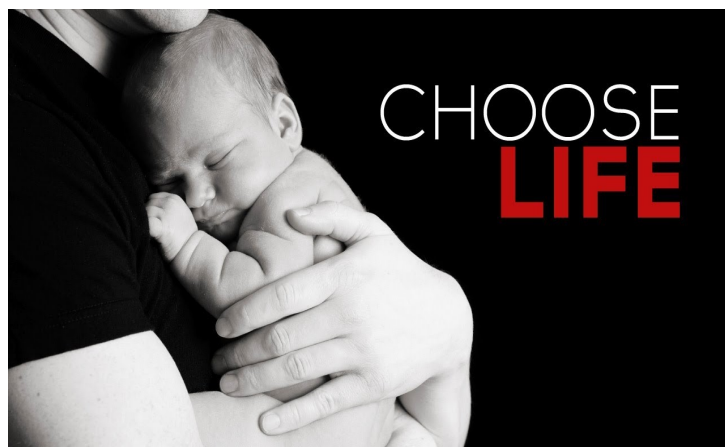

## **DEVOÇÃO AO SAGRADA CORAÇÃO**

Devoção ao Sagrado Coração de Jesus é uma bela devoção de amor ao Redentor do nosso Senhor. Vamos dedicar a primeira sexta-feira de cada mês a este devoção.
