Dear St. Joseph's Parishioner,

One year ago, I announced to the whole parish community that we would be preparing for the 150th Anniversary of the founding of our Church. This coming March, we will have a parish celebration to mark this important moment in the history of our parish. Please mark your calendar for the weekend of March 18th and 19th – more information will be forthcoming.

When I first announced this two-year period of preparation for this significant anniversary, I also announced a two-year Capital Campaign to raise the funds necessary to make some repairs around our church, parish office and property. As you are aware, I set forth a goal of \$250,000 to be raised over the two years. As we reach the halfway mark of the two-year campaign, I want to provide an update to all parishioners.

I am sure you have all been able to see the wonderful work that has been done already. I point out in particular, the exterior woodwork and painting to the church and parish office, the new windows on the first floor of the office building, the new landscaping, and of course the beautiful new tabernacle for our Eucharistic Lord. We have also been able to complete the third stage of the ongoing organ restoration project.

I am pleased that we are more than halfway to that total and slightly ahead of schedule to reach our goal. We are currently at \$131,000. I am overwhelmed by the generosity of our parishioners and other benefactors. Thank you all so much for your continued support of our parish.

As we enter year two of this important campaign, I want to encourage all parishioners to consider being a part of, or continuing in your support of this important campaign to ensure the maintenance and financial security of our parish. We have a rich history and tradition at St. Joseph's. Many of you were raised here, have received your sacraments here, raised your families here and we all want to make sure that St. Joseph's Parish is around for at least another 150 Years. I humbly ask for your support in year two of this capital campaign.

Please be assured of my prayers for each of you and your families and especially for those who are sick, for your children and for those who have family members who are away from the Church. Through the intercession of St. Joseph, our patron, may the Lord bless our parish.



Aqueles que se encontram em tais situações são considerados em estado de pecado grave e devem abster-se de receber a Sagrada Comunhão até que a situação seja resolvida. Como esses casos estão se tornando cada vez mais comuns, surgem muitos problemas, inclusive quando alguém em tal situação deseja ser padrinho de batismo ou confirmação e não se qualifica. A Igreja, na sua misericórdia, procura conciliar todas as situações e disponibiliza os meios necessários para o fazer, seja o processo de anulação para os divorciados, seja a convalidação (bênção) dos casados civilmente.
