## LENTEN ADULT FAITH FORMATION SERIES

## DIOCESAN LENTEN REGULATIONS

All adults 18 and older are bound to the law of fast up to their 60th year, limited to a single full meal that is meatless. Two other meatless meals may be taken to maintain one's needs, but together they shall not equal a full meal. The two prescribed days of Fast are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are 14 years of age and older are obliged to serve the Law of Abstinence from meat on all Fridays of Lent, as well as of course Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

An integral part of the Lenten Season is repenting of our sinful behaviors. It will an opportunity for confessions with a number of visiting priests on Wednesday night, March 6th at St. Joseph's church from 6:30-8PM.
