

It is a great honor when we are asked to be a Godparent (or Sponsor) for a baptism or confirmation. To obtain a sponsor certificate, please see Fr. To be a Godparent, one must be a registered parishioner, have received their Confirmation, attend Mass regularly and be in a valid marriage (Church wedding) and live a good moral life.

RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION

In order that we might maintain social distancing and reverence for the Blessed Sacrament, I am kindly asking that for the reception of Holy Communion, everyone either kneel or stand behind the kneeler. Again, please approach the altar using only the center aisle and return using only the side aisle. When receiving, please remove or lower the mask so that we do not risk dropping the sacred host, the Body of our Lord. If receiving on the hand, please make sure you don't have anything in your hand, (mask, rosary, etc.). Thank you for your cooperation and understanding and reverence for our Lord present to us in the Most Holy Eucharist.
