LENTEN OBSERVANCES

Lent is a special time of penance, sacrifice and simplicity of life, to help us each embrace the Lord's call to conversion. Each of the sacrifices we make (the things that — “*we give up*” for Lent) are meant to aid us in the process of sanctification — growing in holiness. I encourage you to keep faithful to these sacrifices for the entire 40 days of Lent. What a great blessing voluntary sacrifices can be to our spiritual growth.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS

There are many opportunities to pray the Stations of the Cross during Lent. Join us each Friday of Lent.

DAILY MASS AND ADORATION

In addition to all of these wonderful things happening at our Parishes this Lent, I also strongly encourage embracing the things that we have all the time, especially daily Mass each morning and Eucharistic Adoration each Tuesday, as well as at our Daily Adoration chapel.

BIBLE STUDY

Our Bible Study, led by Director of Adult Faith Formation, Jean Revil, continues on Tuesdays, at 9:30AM and 7PM at St. Joseph's school. This could be a great Lenten practice.

LENTEN PROGRAM

During this program we'll be looking at the journey between the events we call “birth” and “death.” This is important because this journey has eternal consequences! SANCTUARY LAMPS

In both of our churches and at the Adoration Chapel, parishioners have the opportunity to reserve the lamps lit in memory of their loved ones. The Sanctuary and Chapel Lamps are \$15, and the Altar of the Blessed Sacrament lamps are \$15 together. Please contact the parish office for more information.

BLESSING OF MARRIAGES

Baptized Catholics are to marry in a Church or chapel with a priest or deacon officiating. Without a proper dispensation from the bishop, Catholics who are married by non-Catholic ministers (such as a Justice of the Peace) or not married in a Church are not considered by the Church as validly joined in a sacramental marriage. The same holds true for divorced Catholics who remarry without first obtaining an annulment from their first marriage. Those who find themselves in such situations are considered to be in a state of grave sin, and should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until the situation is resolved. As these cases are becoming more and more common it presents many issues, including when someone in such a situation wishes to be a godparent for a baptism or confirmation, and does not qualify. The Church, in her mercy, seeks to reconcile all situations and provides the means necessary to do so, whether the annulment process for those who are divorced, or the convalidation (blessing) of those civilly married. For those who find themselves in such a situation, and wish to remedy the situation, please speak directly with Fr. Jay.

OLD PALMS AND BLESSED RELIGIOUS ITEMS

People often ask what to do with items that have been blessed, but no longer being used or are broken/worn out such as prayer cards, books, rosaries and palms. Such items such be either burned or buried, but not thrown out in the trash. If you are unable to burn or bury such items but need to get rid of them, we will have a box at the entrance of the Church next weekend. It is a good time to get rid of old palms especially as we get new ones on Palm Sunday.

FOLLOWING GUIDELINES AT MASS

We ask that you please review our guidelines for opening our churches during the current health situation, and continued to wear your masks and observe social distancing. Please use hand sanitizer upon entrance and exit of church, as well as before and after receiving Holy Communion. Please refrain from any form of the Sign of Peace. Please use only center aisle for Communion.
