PAINTING OF CHURCH AND RECTORY

I have met with contractors and members of the parish finance committee and it was decided that the project would begin this august. Obviously a project of this size will take a few weeks and will be quite expensive. As I mentioned at all Masses last weekend, we will be beginning a capital campaign for this project and other small projects in preparation the our 150th anniversary of our parish in 2023. As we have seen so many of our city churches fall into disrepair and close, it is so important that we do complete this project in a timely manner. I know that I can count on your generous support.
