ROOF AT ST. MICHAEL'S CHURCH

The roof on St. Michael's Church needs to be replaced. After meeting with representatives from the Diocesan Office of Facilities and roofing companies, it has been decided that we need to put a new roof on our Church. This will be a major project that will cost us between \$60-70,000. I am hoping that we can get the work done as soon as possible to prevent any more leaking and water damage in the Church. The maintenance of our buildings is a major factor to the diocese when making decisions about pastoral planning and the future of each parish and Church. As always, thank you for your generosity. To date, we have raised \$6,771 towards this project.
